

Terms of Service

Last updated: 1 June 2026

These **Terms of Service** (“Terms”) govern access to and use of the websites, interfaces, applications, APIs, dashboards, transaction relay, gas sponsorship features, strategy access features and related software services made available by **VENT AI LIMITED**, a company incorporated in Cyprus with registration number **HE 447148** and registered office at **Riga Feraiou, 4 OMEGA COURT, GROUND FLOOR, Office 07, 3095, Limassol, Cyprus** (“**UFarm**”, “**we**”, “**us**” or “**our**”).

By accessing or using the Services, you agree to these Terms. If you use the Services on behalf of a company or other organization, you confirm that you have authority to bind that organization.

1. Important regulatory notice

UFarm provides non-custodial software, technical infrastructure and information interfaces. UFarm is not a bank, credit institution, electronic money institution, payment institution, investment firm, fund manager, broker, dealer, exchange, trading venue, crypto-asset service provider, custodian, portfolio manager, investment adviser, tax adviser or legal adviser, unless expressly stated in a separate written agreement signed by UFarm.

The Services are not intended to constitute, and UFarm does not provide, custody or administration of crypto-assets, operation of a crypto-asset trading platform, exchange of crypto-assets for funds, exchange of crypto-assets for other crypto-assets, execution of orders, placing of crypto-assets, reception and transmission of orders, advice on crypto-assets, portfolio management, transfer services for crypto-assets on behalf of clients, payment services, e-money services, issuance or redemption of e-money tokens or asset-referenced tokens, or any service that requires authorization unless provided by an appropriately authorized third party under its own terms.

Nothing on the Services is financial, investment, legal, tax, accounting or other regulated advice. UFarm does not recommend that you buy, sell, hold, stake, lend, borrow, deposit, withdraw, allocate to, or interact with any crypto-asset, protocol, smart contract, strategy or third-party service.

Where a regulated third-party provider makes a product, strategy, on-ramp, off-ramp, payment, custody, advisory, portfolio management or other regulated service available through or in connection with the Services, that service is provided solely by that third party under its own terms, disclosures, licenses and regulatory responsibility. UFarm is not responsible for the third party’s regulated service except to the extent required by applicable law.

2. The Services

The Services may include: (a) non-custodial wallet connection features; (b) dashboards and analytics; (c) interfaces to blockchain networks, smart contracts and third-party protocols;

(d) a technical relay that broadcasts user-signed blockchain transactions; (e) discretionary gas sponsorship; (f) access to third-party strategy information and strategy providers; (g) links or integrations with third-party on-ramp or other service providers; and (h) support and account-management features.

UFarm may add, change, suspend or discontinue any part of the Services, subject to applicable law and any mandatory consumer rights. We may do so for security, legal, regulatory, operational, product or commercial reasons.

3. Eligibility

You must be at least 18 years old and have legal capacity to enter into these Terms.

You may not use the Services if you are located in, established in, ordinarily resident in, or acting on behalf of a person located in, any jurisdiction or territory where such use would be unlawful or where UFarm restricts access for legal, sanctions, regulatory, security or commercial reasons ("Restricted Jurisdiction").

You must not be subject to financial sanctions, trade embargoes, asset freezes or similar restrictions imposed by the European Union, United Nations or any other authority applicable to UFarm or the relevant Service.

We may require information to verify eligibility and may suspend or terminate access if we reasonably believe that you are not eligible or that your use may breach law, sanctions, these Terms or third-party rights.

4. Non-custodial wallet model

UFarm does not create, hold, control, manage or recover your wallet, private keys, seed phrase, passwords, MPC fragments, session keys, access credentials or other means of accessing crypto-assets ("Access Means").

You are solely responsible for securing your Access Means and devices. Loss, compromise or disclosure of Access Means may result in irreversible loss of crypto-assets. UFarm cannot restore wallets, reverse transactions or retrieve assets from blockchain networks or smart contracts.

Connecting a wallet to the Services does not give UFarm custody or control of your crypto-assets. All blockchain transactions must be initiated and cryptographically authorized by you or by your wallet under your control.

5. User-signed transactions, relay and gas sponsorship

Certain features allow you to generate and sign blockchain transaction payloads or instructions using your own wallet or client-side software ("User Instructions"). You are responsible for reviewing and approving the final User Instruction before signing.

If you submit a signed User Instruction to UFarm for broadcast, UFarm acts only as a technical relay. UFarm may transmit the signed payload or a related wrapper transaction to a blockchain network, mempool, node, RPC provider or other technical infrastructure. UFarm

does not select the asset, recipient, amount, smart contract, strategy, timing, route, parameters or economic purpose of your User Instruction.

For account-abstraction, meta-transaction or gas-sponsorship flows, UFarm or a service provider may sponsor or pay network fees required to submit a transaction. Gas sponsorship is discretionary, may be limited, withdrawn, refused or changed at any time, and does not create a payment account, stored value, e-money balance, reimbursement right, transfer service or fiduciary relationship.

UFarm may refuse, delay or fail to relay any User Instruction for technical, security, abuse-prevention, sanctions, compliance, network, smart-contract, operational or other legitimate reasons. UFarm has no duty to monitor the economic merits of any User Instruction and does not owe you any duty to execute, prioritize, optimize, cancel or reverse a transaction.

Blockchain transactions may be irreversible once submitted. Network congestion, gas pricing, RPC failures, validator behavior, MEV, front-running, smart-contract bugs or other factors may cause failure, delay, slippage, unexpected costs or loss.

6. Third-party strategies and strategy providers

The Services may display or provide access to strategies, vaults, portfolios, pools, smart contracts, managed arrangements or other products operated, managed, sponsored or made available by independent third-party entities ("Strategy Providers").

UFarm does not manage strategies, set discretionary parameters, rebalance portfolios, select strategies for you, provide personalized recommendations, assess suitability or appropriateness, or act as your adviser, agent, broker, portfolio manager, fiduciary or representative.

Strategy Providers are solely responsible for their strategies, regulatory status, licenses, registrations, permissions, marketing rights, offering documents, risk disclosures, performance information, fees, KYC/AML processes, suitability or appropriateness assessments where required, complaint handling, and compliance with laws applicable to their activities.

Information about a strategy may be provided by the relevant Strategy Provider or derived from smart contracts, protocols, or third-party data sources. UFarm may format or display that information, but does not endorse it, verify all of it, or guarantee its accuracy, completeness, timeliness, legality, regulatory status, availability, liquidity, performance or suitability for you.

Before interacting with any strategy, you must review the Strategy Provider's terms, disclosures, fees, risk warnings and regulatory information. Your relationship in respect of a third-party strategy is with the relevant Strategy Provider and/or smart contract or protocol, not with UFarm, except for UFarm's own software Services.

UFarm may list, delist, restrict, hide or suspend access to any strategy or Strategy Provider for legal, regulatory, risk, security, operational, commercial or reputational reasons.

7. No investment advice, no recommendations

All content on the Services is for general information, software-operation or technical-interface purposes only. It is not tailored to your personal circumstances, financial position, investment objectives, experience, knowledge, risk tolerance or tax situation.

Any filters, categories, analytics, APY figures, historical performance data, risk labels, dashboards, charts, rankings or similar materials are generic and informational. They must not be treated as a recommendation, solicitation, offer, invitation, research report, investment advice, crypto-asset advice or portfolio-management service by UFarm.

You are solely responsible for your decisions and should obtain independent professional advice where appropriate.

8. Third-party protocols, smart contracts and data

The Services may connect to or display information about blockchain networks, smart contracts, decentralized protocols, wallets, RPC providers, oracle providers, analytics providers, bridges, token issuers, stablecoin issuers, custodians, payment providers, identity providers and other third parties.

Third-party systems are not controlled by UFarm. They may be unavailable, insecure, defective, exploited, modified, discontinued, manipulated, censored, forked, upgraded or subject to regulatory action. UFarm is not responsible for third-party systems except to the extent required by applicable law.

Smart-contract code and on-chain data may be public. You should not include personal data, confidential information or unlawful content in transaction metadata, memos, calldata, names, public profiles or other public fields.

9. On-ramp, off-ramp and payment partners

Any fiat payment, card payment, bank transfer, e-money, stablecoin purchase, on-ramp, off-ramp, exchange, KYC or related service made available through a link, widget or integration is provided by the relevant third-party provider under its own terms and regulatory permissions.

UFarm does not hold client fiat funds, issue e-money, maintain payment accounts, execute payment transactions, issue or redeem stablecoins, exchange fiat for crypto-assets, or provide payment or e-money services.

UFarm may receive technical, referral or integration fees from third-party providers where permitted by law. Such fees do not change the third party's responsibility for its services or make UFarm the provider of those services.

10. Fees

UFarm may charge fees for certain Services. Applicable UFarm fees will be disclosed before you incur them or in the relevant plan, order form or interface.

Third-party providers, Strategy Providers, blockchain networks, smart contracts and protocols may charge separate fees, spreads, commissions, performance fees, management fees, gas fees, validator fees, withdrawal fees or other charges. You are responsible for reviewing those fees.

Gas sponsorship by UFarm, if any, is a voluntary technical feature. It does not entitle you to cash, reimbursement, stored value, refunds, credits, future gas sponsorship or any payment service.

11. Risks

Crypto-assets, blockchain networks, DeFi protocols and related strategies are high-risk. You may lose all or part of your assets.

Risks include volatility, illiquidity, smart-contract bugs, oracle failures, protocol exploits, governance attacks, validator or sequencer failures, bridges, hacks, private-key compromise, slippage, liquidation, stablecoin de-peg, strategy-provider error or insolvency, regulatory restrictions, tax consequences, market manipulation, MEV, front-running, network congestion and irreversible transactions.

Past performance, APY, yield, TVL, backtests, simulations or historical data do not predict future results. Any displayed return may be inaccurate, delayed, variable, not net of all fees, or unavailable to you.

UFarm does not guarantee availability, profitability, principal protection, redemption, liquidity, tax treatment, regulatory treatment, uninterrupted access or successful transaction completion.

12. User obligations and prohibited use

You must use the Services only for lawful purposes and in accordance with these Terms, applicable law and third-party terms.

You must not: (a) use the Services to violate sanctions, AML, terrorist financing, fraud, market abuse, consumer protection, data protection, securities, financial services, tax or other laws; (b) use the Services to transmit malware, exploit vulnerabilities or attack systems; (c) attempt to bypass geoblocking, compliance, rate limits or security controls; (d) impersonate another person; (e) upload illegal, misleading, infringing or harmful content; (f) interfere with the Services or other users; or (g) use automated means in a way that harms the Services unless we expressly allow it.

You are responsible for taxes, reporting, recordkeeping and legal compliance arising from your use of the Services.

13. Accounts and security

Some features may require an account, wallet connection, email, passkey, identity check or other access method. You must provide accurate information and keep it updated.

You are responsible for all activity under your account, wallet and devices. Notify us promptly if you suspect unauthorized access or security compromise.

We may apply security measures, rate limits, transaction limits, geoblocking, wallet screening, sanctions screening or other controls where we consider them necessary or appropriate.

14. Privacy

Our processing of personal data is described in the UFarm Privacy Policy available at <https://ufarm.digital/privacy-policy>, as updated from time to time.

Blockchain transactions and public smart-contract interactions may be visible to anyone and may be impossible for UFarm to delete or modify. Do not put personal data or confidential information on public blockchains or in public content fields.

15. User content, provider content and DSA notice-and-action

If the Services allow you, a Strategy Provider or another third party to submit, store, publish or display content, data, descriptions, documents, images, names, comments, profiles or other materials (“Content”), you are responsible for that Content.

You must not submit Content that is illegal, misleading, fraudulent, defamatory, discriminatory, infringing, privacy-invasive, harmful, malicious, spam, market-manipulative, or otherwise incompatible with these Terms.

UFarm may moderate, restrict, remove, hide, label, disable access to or demote Content, or suspend accounts, where we reasonably believe Content is illegal, infringes rights, creates security or regulatory risk, or breaches these Terms.

To report illegal Content or a breach of these Terms, contact legal@ufarm.digital and include: (a) URL or location of the Content; (b) why you believe it is illegal or breaches these Terms; (c) your name and email; and (d) a statement that your report is accurate and made in good faith. We may request additional information.

Where required by applicable law, we will provide a statement of reasons for certain moderation decisions and make available an internal complaint mechanism or other redress channel. You may contact legal@ufarm.digital to appeal a moderation decision.

These DSA-related clauses apply only to the extent the Services fall within the relevant scope of the Digital Services Act or similar laws. They do not convert UFarm into a publisher, adviser, broker, distributor or regulated provider of any third-party strategy.

16. Intellectual property

UFarm and its licensors own the Services, software, interfaces, design, trademarks, logos, documentation, databases and other UFarm materials, except for third-party materials and Content owned by others.

Subject to these Terms, UFarm grants you a limited, revocable, non-exclusive, non-transferable, non-sublicensable right to access and use the Services for their intended purpose.

You must not copy, modify, reverse engineer, scrape, resell, sublicense, frame or create derivative works from the Services except as permitted by law or by written permission from VENT AI LIMITED.

You retain rights in your Content. You grant UFarm a worldwide, non-exclusive, royalty-free license to host, store, process, display, transmit, format and use your Content as necessary to provide, secure, operate and improve the Services and comply with law.

17. Open-source and third-party software

The Services may include or interact with open-source software and third-party software subject to separate licenses. Those licenses may grant you rights or impose obligations independent of these Terms.

UFarm does not grant rights to third-party software beyond those provided by the applicable third-party license.

18. Service availability, beta features and changes

The Services may be unavailable or degraded due to maintenance, upgrades, outages, attacks, network issues, third-party failures, blockchain congestion, legal restrictions or other events.

Some features may be marked or operate as beta, experimental, preview or early-access features. Such features may be unstable, incomplete, inaccurate, changed or discontinued at any time.

For consumers, nothing in this section limits mandatory rights that cannot be waived under applicable law.

19. Suspension and termination

You may stop using the Services at any time. You remain responsible for your blockchain positions, third-party accounts, taxes and obligations.

We may suspend, restrict or terminate access to all or part of the Services if: (a) you breach these Terms; (b) we reasonably suspect fraud, abuse, security risk, sanctions or illegal activity; (c) required by law, court order, regulator, third-party provider or blockchain/protocol constraints; (d) necessary to protect UFarm, users, partners or the Services; or (e) a Service is discontinued.

Suspension or termination of UFarm access does not necessarily close positions, cancel transactions, recover assets or terminate your relationship with third-party providers, protocols or Strategy Providers. You are responsible for managing those relationships and positions.

20. Consumer withdrawal and mandatory rights

If you are an EU consumer and purchase a paid digital service from UFarm, you may have a statutory withdrawal right unless an exception applies. Where applicable, we may ask you to request immediate performance and acknowledge that the withdrawal right is lost once the digital service has begun or been provided, to the extent permitted by law.

Nothing in these Terms excludes or limits rights that you have as a consumer and that cannot lawfully be excluded or limited, including rights relating to digital content or digital services, unfair contract terms, liability for fraud, intentional misconduct, gross negligence, death or personal injury, or local mandatory consumer courts.

Crypto-asset transactions, third-party strategy interactions and blockchain transactions may be irreversible and may not be capable of withdrawal, cancellation or refund by UFarm.

21. Disclaimers

To the maximum extent permitted by law, the Services are provided on an “as is” and “as available” basis. UFarm disclaims warranties of merchantability, fitness for a particular purpose, title, non-infringement, accuracy, uninterrupted operation, security, profitability, regulatory status and error-free performance.

UFarm does not warrant that any blockchain transaction will be accepted, confirmed, executed, final, reversible, profitable or free from error, attack, delay, slippage, tax liability or regulatory consequence.

UFarm does not warrant any third-party strategy, protocol, smart contract, wallet, on-ramp, payment provider, data source or Strategy Provider.

22. Liability

Nothing in these Terms limits liability that cannot be limited under applicable law.

To the maximum extent permitted by law, UFarm will not be liable for indirect, incidental, special, consequential, punitive or exemplary damages; loss of profits, revenue, goodwill, data, crypto-assets, business opportunity or anticipated savings; or losses caused by blockchain networks, smart contracts, third-party providers, Strategy Providers, user error, compromised Access Means, regulatory action or market movements.

To the maximum extent permitted by law, UFarm’s aggregate liability arising out of or relating to the Services and these Terms is limited to the greater of: (a) fees paid by you to UFarm for the affected paid Service in the three months before the event giving rise to liability; and (b) EUR 100. This limitation does not apply where prohibited by applicable consumer law.

23. Indemnity

If you use the Services as a business, organization or professional user, you will indemnify UFarm and its officers, directors, employees, contractors and affiliates against claims, losses, damages, liabilities, penalties, fines and expenses arising from your breach of these Terms, unlawful use of the Services, Content, or violation of third-party rights.

For consumers, this clause applies only to the extent permitted by applicable law.

24. Complaints and support

Complaints about a Strategy Provider, regulated strategy, on-ramp, payment, KYC, custody, exchange or other third-party service should be directed to the relevant third-party provider under its own complaint procedure. UFarm may assist with routing your complaint where reasonably possible but is not responsible for the third party’s complaint handling unless required by law.

The EU Online Dispute Resolution platform has been discontinued. If applicable law requires ADR information, UFarm will provide it in the relevant country-specific notice.

25. Governing law and disputes

These Terms are governed by the laws of Cyprus, excluding conflict-of-law rules.

If you are a business user, the courts of Cyprus have exclusive jurisdiction over disputes arising from or relating to these Terms or the Services.

If you are an EU consumer, this governing-law and jurisdiction clause does not deprive you of mandatory consumer protections or mandatory court rights in the country of your habitual residence.

26. Changes to these Terms

We may update these Terms from time to time. We will provide notice of material changes by posting the updated Terms, changing the “Last updated” date, or using other reasonable means.

Changes will not reduce mandatory consumer rights that cannot be waived. If you do not agree to updated Terms, you must stop using the Services.

27. Miscellaneous

These Terms, together with any referenced policies or applicable order forms, are the entire agreement between you and UFarm regarding the Services.

If any provision is invalid or unenforceable, the remaining provisions remain in effect and the invalid provision will be interpreted or replaced to achieve its lawful purpose as closely as possible.

You may not assign these Terms without UFarm’s consent. UFarm may assign these Terms in connection with a merger, reorganization, financing, sale of assets or transfer of business, subject to applicable law.

UFarm’s failure to enforce a provision is not a waiver. Headings are for convenience only.

28. Definitions

“Crypto-assets” means digital representations of value or rights that may be transferred and stored electronically using distributed ledger technology or similar technology, without implying that any particular asset is regulated or unregulated.

“Services” has the meaning given in the introduction and Section 2.

“Strategy Provider” means an independent third party that operates, manages, sponsors, markets or makes available a strategy, vault, portfolio, pool, smart contract, product or related service accessible through or referenced by the Services.

“User Instruction” means a blockchain transaction payload or instruction generated, approved or signed by you or your wallet, including payloads used in account-abstraction, meta-transaction or gas-sponsorship flows.
